Coastal Carolina Regional Airport Terminal Expansion Begins

NEW BERN, Craven County — Changes are finally underway at Coastal Carolina Regional Airport (EWN).

The terminal expansion at the airport, planned to be completed in late summer of 2024, began Tuesday.

According to a post on the airport's Facebook page, the expansion includes new gates and dedicated airplane boarding bridges. It will also have a new terminal entrance canopy, new modern restrooms, and an area for service animals. All construction is scheduled for completion by late summer 2024.

The airport also said it will improve its security screening checkpoints, improve the bathrooms, and extend the baggage claim belt. The airport hopes these changes will bring more visitors, and business, to Eastern Carolina.

FAYETTEVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT UNVEILS \$37 MILLION TERMINAL RENOVATION

Fayetteville Regional Airport unveiled its terminal renovations and expansion on Wednesday, according to a city news release.

The renovations include a new entrance canopy; enhanced security screening area; reconstruction of the rental parking lot; Concourse B upgrades; new airline offices and counter spaces; new escalators and elevators; upgraded baggage claim wings; and new administrative offices, according to the news release.

Airport Director Toney Coleman presided at Wednesday's ceremony.

In addition to Coleman, speakers included Mark Lynch, chairman of the Airport Commission, Mayor Mitch Colvin; City Councilwoman Courtney Banks-McLaughlin; and City Manager Doug Hewett.

The more than \$37 million in renovations were financed through grants from the Federal Aviation Administration, state of North Carolina, and airport's fund balance, the release said.

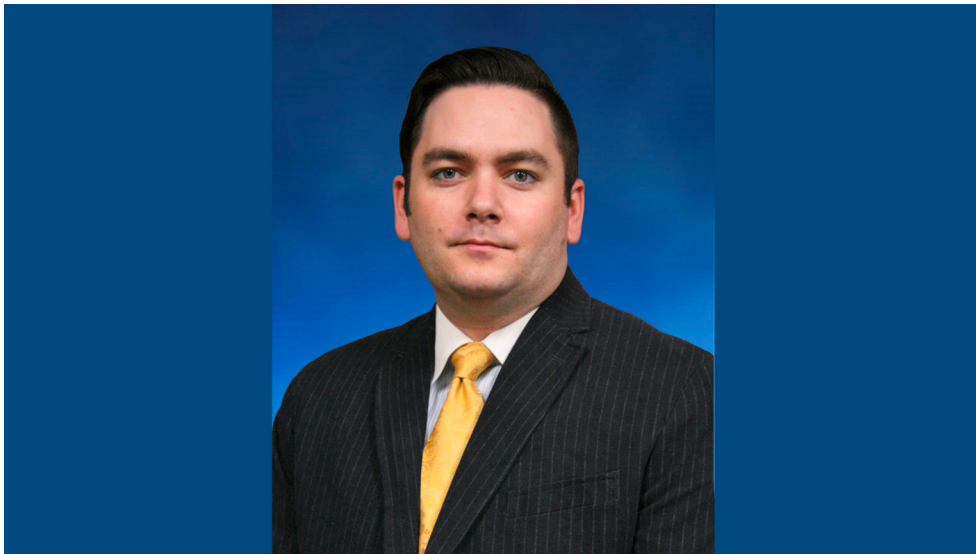

2022 Airport Business Top 40 Under 40

Roy Remington

Roy Remington was first interested in aviation hearing stories from a friend's grandfather was a tailgunner on a B-17 Flying Fortress in World War II. He started on a path to become a pilot and switched to aviation engineering. While working with clients, he became intrigued by the kinship airport directors have and the range of duties they undertake in a daily basis. That drove him to pursue a career in airport management.

"The only thing constant in aviation is change," he said. For as much as we try to build predictability into the industry, we'll never control the wind or the pace of technological progress. Each day presents something new and we have the opportunity to embrace the uncertainty of it."

Remington has served as the executive director of the Millington-Memphis Airport (NQA) for nine years. He inherited an airport in dire need of recapitalization. The former air station turned municipal airport faced major infrastructure challenges, which Remington was able to address via \$40 million in investments.

He was named Airport Manager of the Year by TDOT Aeronautics for his work developing the University of Memphis flight school degree program at the Airport; and AAAE awarded him Airport Project of the Year Architectural Category for his work restoring the 1942 B-17 Flying Fortress Memphis Belle Hangar at the airport.

Remington received the 2022 Airport Project of the Year Airfield Category from AAAE for keeping NQA open by converting a taxiway to a landing strip while the airport's only runway was being reconstructed. He was awarded the Rebuild Tennessee Award by the Tennessee Development Association for his work overseeing construction of a new \$2.9M entrance road to the airport.

Remington was elected by his peers in 2019 to serve as president of the Tennessee Aviation Association. He has overseen legislative efforts to preserve state airport funding and has held statewide outreach events for fellow airport managers.

In 2019, Remington founded the Midsouth Airshow with the vision of bringing the Blue Angels to Memphis to inspire the next generation of aerospace and STEM leaders. Remington made admission to the show free for children and oversaw the most successful air show on record while serving as show director in 2022.

Making good on his promise, Remington organized youth outreach events during the show including special Blue Angels meetings with critically ill Make-A-Wish children, Organization of Black Aerospace Professionals (OBAP) youth, Boy Scout Troops, Sea Cadets, and Civil Air Patrol squadrons.

In his free time, Remington travels the country as a volunteer with Dream Flights, a non-profit dedicated to helping military veterans relive the magic of flight by gifting them with WWII era biplane rides.

"I mostly enjoy how natural my position comes, it shows that airport management is my passion," He said. "I feel as if I have the best job in the world. I'm able to manage airport finance, airport planning & development, airport engineering, airport operations, airport maintenance, airport law, airport marketing, and airport revenue. Even more, my place of work has a family environment and my colleagues are team-oriented, which is why we've been successful with completing a \$21 million Terminal Renovation Phase I and are in the midst of wrapping up with Terminal Renovation Phase II with a project cost of \$33 million."

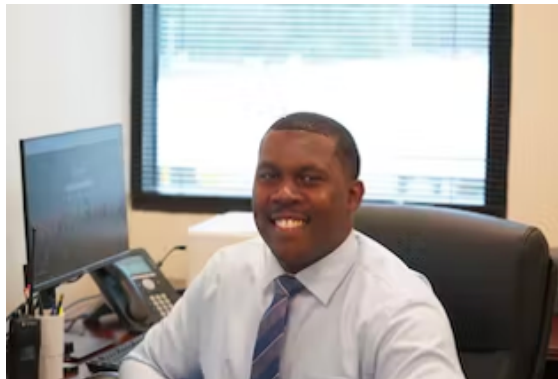
His early interest in pursuing this type of career stems from his undergraduate time at Tennessee State University, studying aeronautical & industrial technology with a minor in aviation management. After graduating with his Bachelor of Science degree, Watson obtained an MBA in aviation finance from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. Watson is also an Accredited Airport Executive (A.A.E.) and Airport Certified Employee (ACE) through the trade organization, American Association of Airport Executives.

Recently, Watson was nominated to serve on the board of directors of the North Carolina Airports Association where he will help support the growth and sustainability of the 72 airports in the statewide aviation system.

"I like the impact airports have on our communities; being able to connect people from all different walks of life is so rewarding," said Watson. "Working with other industry leaders to make this happen is even more gratifying."

Looking to the future, Watson said he would like to see airports continue to work together, work with regulatory and with airlines to support travelers.

"I would also like to see more educational programs offered by airports to spark interest in the aerospace workforce for our leaders of tomorrow," He said. "The Fayetteville Regional Airport noticed a decline not only in pilots but in our industry entirely, therefore, we hosted a four-day Aviation Career Education Academy to introduce the various careers available in our industry. In my daily walk of life, I incorporate unselfish living and make it my duty to lift others as I climb. I want to be able to indirectly support aviation recruitment efforts by being an industry educator as needed and continue to be an aviation education advocate."

2022 Airport Business Top 40 Under 40: Matthew D. Dowell, A.A.E.

Matthew D. Dowell, A.A.E., says his dream job is executive director of the Golden Triangle Regional Airport (GTR). That's the job he has now.

Dowell served as the airport's operations manager, then as deputy director for more than nine years. During that time, he helped the airport grow more than 50 percent in nearly every metric.

GTR was one of the first in the country to integrate drone operations, leveraging the nearby Mississippi State University's FAA Center of Excellence for UAS to help improve airport operations.

To increase the reliability and redundancy of power to the airport, Dowell is developing a plan for the use of renewable energy sources.

Finally, he helped move the entire parking operation to a technologically independent system that increased revenues while reducing manpower requirements.

These accomplishments led to him being selected as the next executive director.

"I first got involved in aviation because of my passion for flying," said Dowell, whose grandfather and uncle were Air Force pilots. "I love working at an airport and around airplanes. I enjoy spending my days helping to improve our airport and, by doing so, helping to improve the communities we serve. I'm fortunate to work at a great airport with excellent colleagues, tenants, and customers."

"There is a sense of camaraderie and mutual support in the airport industry," he continued. "Airport professionals have a collective endeavor and ethos to make the whole aviation industry thrive. Aviation is full of passionate professionals who work daily to help the industry. Gaining friends, colleagues and mentors is the best part of being in the aviation industry."

Dowell serves as a committee chair for the Young Leaders Committee of the Southeast Chapter of AAE and an ambassador for the Aviation Cooperative Research Program.

"Aviation is an evolving industry, and I hope to see continued innovations," he said. "I want the public to become more familiar with airports value and their economic impact on the economy. I hope to see more businesses and organizations invest in airports to offer more job opportunities and economic development. I would like to see airports grow the services they provide. Such as serving as a centralized transportation hub for air and land transportation. I would love to see more railways, vertiports, air cargo facilities, and spaceports located at airports. I'd like to see airports create advanced infrastructure to better serve technology like autonomous, electric, and supersonic aircraft. I hope that airports can become a place people can visit to learn more about aviation and aerospace and their advanced technology. I want to see airports help inspire the next generation of aviators and enthusiasts."
